

## **FJAA Fall Field Day 2013 Contest Info**

Photography: - Four age divisions(age as of Jan. 1) : Peewee: 8 and under  
Junior: 9 – 13  
Intermediate: 14 – 17  
Senior: 18-21

**Angus Cattle** - Photographs that highlight Angus cattle on the farm or ranch or at an Angus event. The cattle should be the dominate focus of the picture.

**Landscape** - Photographs that focus on scenery around the farm or ranch. Angus cattle should be included in the photo.

**People** - Photographs that show an Angus junior and/or family, friends, fellow junior members, etc., either involved in activities on the farm or ranch or at an Angus event.

**Around the Farm or Ranch** – Photographs that highlight activities and scenes around the farm or ranch.

### **Rules:**

1. Contestants must be members of the Florida Junior Angus Association (FJAA).
2. All work must be that of the entrant.
3. Photos are to be 8x10-inch (in.) color or black-and-white prints mounted on a 10x14-in. black foam core. Photos should not be matted or framed. Mount the completed entry form on the back side (**can be found on the last page of contest info**), in the upper left-hand corner of the form core.
4. Photos must be taken by the contestant during the past year. Photo cannot be altered or image-enhanced in any way. Contestants are encouraged to use 35-millimeter (mm) cameras.
5. Photos cannot have been presented for competition at a previous Florida Junior Angus event.

Contestants will be required to submit a title page and a typed, double spaced outline of their speech on 8.5" x 11" white paper **with their entry form (Due Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013)**

A title page must accompany the outline when submitted. It must include the title of the speech and the speaker's name, address, member code, birth date and age as of Jan. 1.

### **The Speech**

1. Any subject pertaining to Angus cattle or the beef industry is acceptable for the junior and intermediate divisions. Exploration of, and insight into, any and all phases of the industry are encouraged. Current affairs, policies and trends provide good topics.

**2. The 2013 senior speech topic is: Discuss the current cow inventory and its impact on the beef industry.**

3. The speech must be the result of the contestant's own efforts and cannot have been presented for competition at a previous Florida Junior Angus event.

4. Each speech in the junior division will be four to six minutes in length and the intermediate and senior division shall be between six and eight minutes in length. Deductions of a half a point per ten seconds will be made from the score by each judge for speeches under or over the specified length. A 1 minute warning will be given by event officials.

5. Each contestant will be allowed up to five minutes to answer questions from the judges.

6. Contestants will be permitted to use notes. Excessive reference to notes, however, may result in scoring deductions. The use of visual aids (charts, signs, slides, etc.) is not allowed.

7. Judges shall receive copies of the outline prior to the contest so that the general idea of the speech may be reviewed before actual presentation.

8. The judges will ask questions after each speech. Contestants will be graded on their ability to respond effectively.

9. The contestant will be scored on the basis of 50 points with 20% in organization and content, 20% in language and delivery, 20% in presentation, 20% in total effectiveness, and 20% in response to questions.
